



## **TYNEDALE CRICKET CLUB –JUNIORS PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO POLICY**

1. Photographs/images/recordings are not to be taken at matches, or training, without the prior permission of the parents/carers of the child – this is noted on the Tynedale Tigers Cricket Club annual membership form. This permission will allow the Club to use appropriate images on its website, or publicity material.
2. Where consent is not given, the relevant coaches/team managers must be informed of the decision. They must then make visiting teams or coaches aware of any players who must be excluded from photography/recording.
3. When using images of children for public viewing (e.g. on social media, websites, newspapers), a child's name should not be linked to a picture without additional and specific consent.
4. Children are to be informed before they are photographed and told how those images will be used. All images must be within a relevant cricket setting with appropriate match/training clothing.
5. Children, parents/carers should raise any general concerns to their coach/team manager. Anyone with concerns regarding inappropriate, or intrusive, photography is to inform the Club Welfare Officers.
6. The use of video must only be used within an appropriate coaching programme.
7. Any recordings are to be held securely and deleted when requested by a parent/carer, or when no longer needed.
- 8. The use of any imaging device – cameras, mobile phones, iPads, or similar- is strictly forbidden in changing areas.**
9. It is the responsibility of the parent/carer to inform the Club of any changes to consent.
